



CAMP RULES

Dear Participants,

We kindly request your cooperation in adhering to the following guidelines to maintain the sanctity and harmony of our Sadhana Camp:

- 1. The camp is a place of self-reflection. All members are kindly requested to collaborate in fostering a tranquil atmosphere, essential for upholding the sanctity of the camp.
- 2. Please remain on the camp premises at all times and inform the camp administrator before leaving the grounds incase of any personal emergency.
- 3. Only registered participants are permitted at the Camp. Friends or relatives dropping off or picking up attendees may accompany them to the hotel lobby area only. During the camp period, they are not allowed to visit participants, even in the hotel lobby.
- 4. Professional babysitters will be available on-site for children aged 5 and under. For children aged 5 and over, a separate Summer Camp with learning and recreation activities will be held simultaneously. Parents are expected to attend all Sadhana Camp sessions, and parent volunteers will oversee babysitting and the Summer Camp on a rotational basis.
- 5. Punctuality and attendance are mandatory for all programs. Participants who are absent three times will be asked to leave the campgrounds unless there is a personal emergency.
- 6. Alcohol consumption, smoking, and reading newspapers are strictly prohibited throughout the duration of the camp.
- 7. Participants are encouraged to engage or conduct any other activities, gathering, groups discussions etc that are not part of the official program.
- 8. Reading materials other than spiritual literature are not allowed as it disturbs the flow.
- 9. Gossip, idle talk, or phone calls are not permitted unless really necessary and unavoidable. Participants are encouraged to observe silence as much as possible (cell phones are prohibited during all the sessions).
- **10.** Members cannot reserve seats in the Satsang Hall for themselves, friends, or relatives. Seating is available on a first-come, first-serve basis, except for the first two rows on both sides, which are reserved for singers and musicians.
- 11. We humbly request all participants to dress modestly throughout the duration of the camp. Kindly avoid wearing tank tops or shorts during the event. If possible, we recommend attire that is fully covered and preferably in white color.

Your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines is greatly appreciated as we strive to create a conducive environment for spiritual growth and learning.
